

- Responsible for overall cash management
- The information reported to MOF is not disaggregated by institution below the aggregate level
- Revenue are recorded by source.
- Expenditures are recorded by level of government, by category and by budgetary line item.

State Social Insurance General Office

Social insurance is divided into five funds, of which one is the Health Insurance Fund

Facilities receiving payments from health insurance fund submit claims using a standardized form, specified by Ministerial order

State Statistical Office

- Nationally-representative Household Income and Expenditure Survey(HIES) since 1967
- For NHA purposes, it is the only survey which can provide indicators of time trends in household expenditures on health during the 1990s.
- The National income account have conformed SNA system since 1990

Conclusion

- Recognized need for reliable, systematic, comprehensive data and information on health expenditures
- The development of NHA framework based on OECD manual is in process
