Guidelines for Field Work

During the field visit, you will be divided into groups and there will be a facilitator for each group from our training team. The Local Supervisor (LS) will be your resource person during fieldwork. The facilitator will help you with translation, both for conversation with the LS and the Person with Disability (PWD) and or with their family members. You are free to ask any questions related to the disability and rehabilitation issues with the LS and with PWD. We are sure that you will do so with sensitivity and respect. During your time and interaction in the field, it would be helpful to keep in mind, the 'points to remember' that are given below. One member from each group has to present a brief report of your visit, the next morning, focussing on what you have learnt in terms of CBR. There will be experts who will guide you through the discussions.

Transport is organized from LCECU by 1.30pm on the fieldwork day and you will be dropped back in LCECU after the visit.

Points to remember

1. Could this condition have been prevented?
2. Was it picked up immediately?
3. What are the problems faced by this person?
4. What is the cause of the disability? (How have these led to the person being disabled?)
5. What activity limitation and participation restriction have occurred because of disability?
6. What is the role of Local Supervisor, family and wider community in addressing his/her problems?
7. What if any is the role of the Secondary and Tertiary care centres
