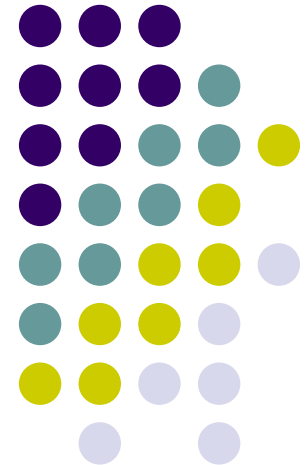

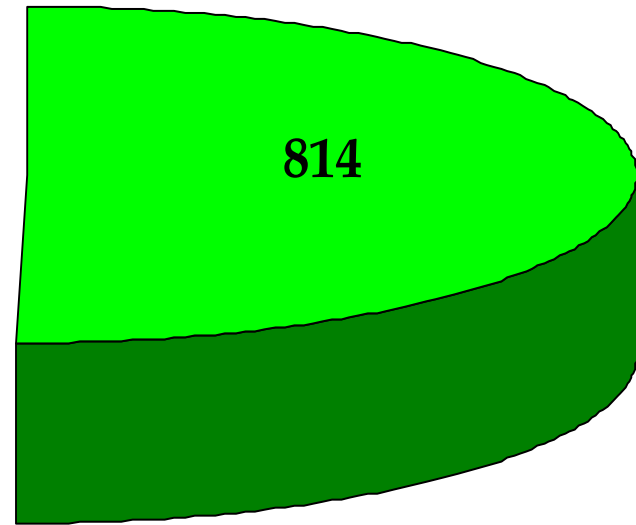
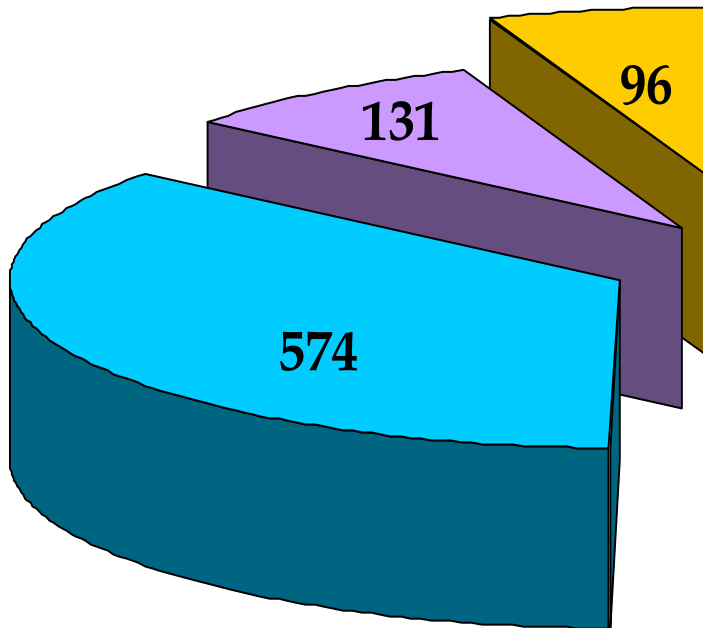
## 2. Centre's Performance

- Timely reminders (6 monthly) sent to clinicians & GPs
- Feedback given to clinicians regarding AEs received
- Lectures taken for post-graduates & GP Associations

## 2d. Progress on specific therapeutic groups allocated to the Centre



- No specific therapeutic group allotted to Centre
- Issues regarding certain therapeutic groups:
  - selective Cox II inhibitors & cisapride – not used since the ban
  - rosuvastatin, droperidol, analgin furazolidone – not commonly prescribed at our hospital
