

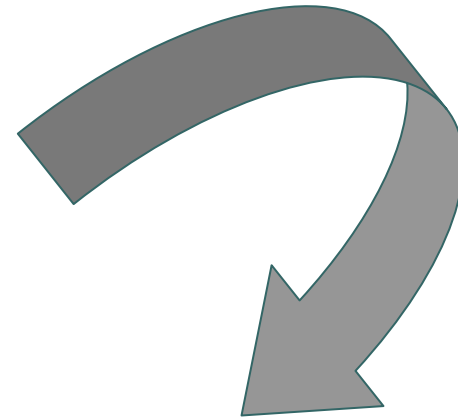

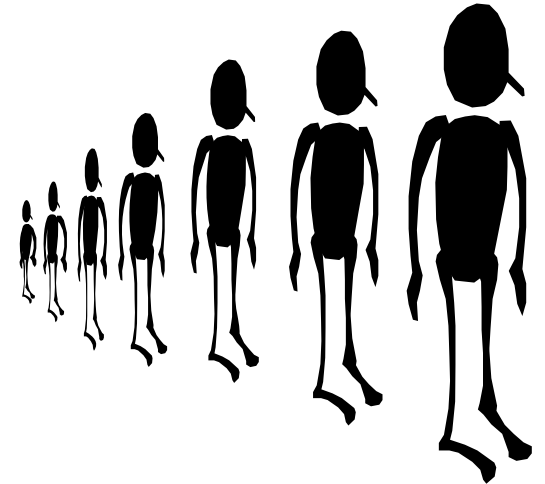

- IT IS **NOT** A WORK FORCE CRISIS IN THE NGO SECTOR.



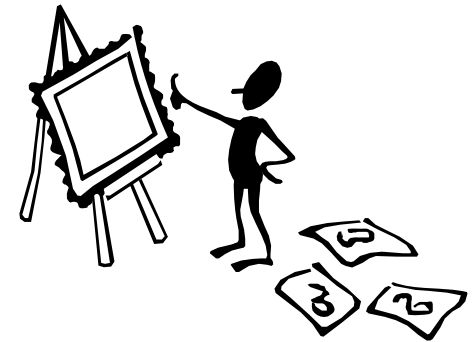
CHALLENGES IN RECRUITMENT

CHALLENGES IN QUALITY OUTPUTS

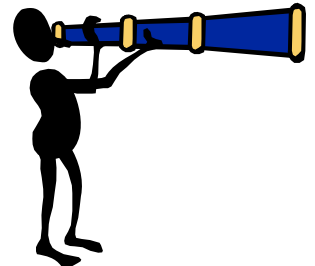
- LACK OF PROFESSIONAL MANAGEMENT
- HESITANCY IN ACCREDITATION





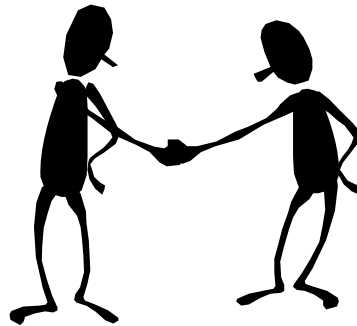
CHALLENGES IN VISION DEVELOPMENT

- TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING



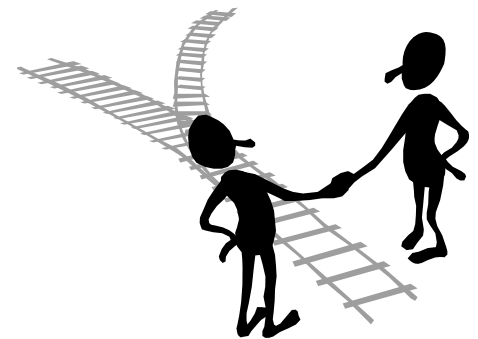
CHALLENGES OF WORKING TOGETHER
